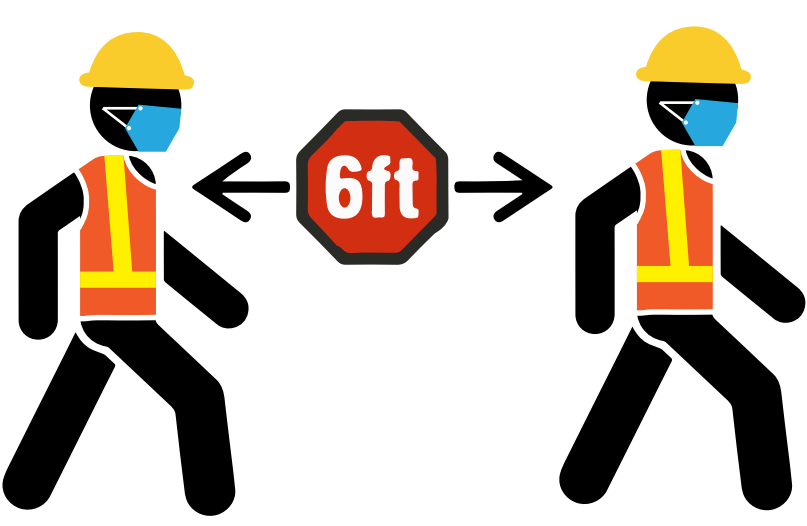


COVID-19 Guidance for Resuming Construction Activities

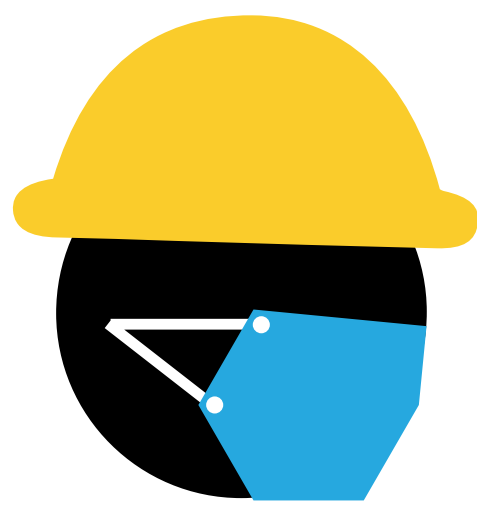
The following guidance is inspired by the New York State Department of Health's document that describes the measures needed to take place in order to safely resume construction activities during the COVID-19 pandemic.



Physical Distancing

Key Points:

- No more than 1 worker per 250 sq ft on site
- Measures to reduce bi-directional traffic (signs, tape, arrows, etc.)
- Reminder signs on site (hand hygiene, 6ft distance, etc.)
- Use webconferencing or teleconferencing for meetings that would traditionally bring together personnel in one space



Proper PPE

Key Points:

- Masks are to be worn on site, and provided by the site owner/GC if a worker does not have access to a mask
- Cloth masks are not to be worn for jobs that would traditionally use a respirator
- Face coverings must not be shared
- Masks are mandatory for site staff screening workers for symptoms



Enhanced Hygiene Practice

Key Points:

- Limit sharing of tools, if sharing is needed, mandate the use of gloves
- Clear access to sanitization stations (sinks with soap and water or sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol)
- No shared food on the jobsite or at break areas
- Staggered breaks are encouraged

Refined Safety Procedures

Ensure Workers are Compliant to Guidelines

On site signage or worker survey acknowledgement that ensures a workers says **NO** to ALL of these three questions - prior to entering the job site, if possible:

- Have you knowingly been in close contact in the past 14 days with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 or who has or had symptoms of COVID-19?
- Have you tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 14 days? or
- Have you experienced any symptoms of COVID-19 in the past 14 days?

ATTENTION! COVID-19 Health Notice

By checking in to the job site at this terminal, I certify that:

- I have not knowingly been in close proximity with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 or who has had symptoms of COVID-19 in the past 14-days.
- AND -
- I have not tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 14-days.
- AND -
- I have not experienced any symptoms of COVID-19 in the past 14-days.

Workers who are feeling unwell, displaying symptoms of COVID-19, or have come into contact with anyone who has tested positive with COVID-19

Real-time tracking of who is on your job site at any given time.

Always Know Who & When a Worker is On the Jobsite

- If a worker screens positive for symptoms, they are not to enter the jobsite
- A site safety monitor must be designated to the site to ensure all necessary precautions are taking place
- To the extent possible, **a log of every person, including workers and visitors**, who may have close contact with other individuals at the work site or area must be maintained

NOTE: If a worker tests positive or is screened with symptoms, and not tested, they are to leave the site and self quarantine for 14-days.

A Proven Ability to Trace Contact

"To the extent possible, a log of every person, including workers and visitors, who may have close contact with other individuals at the work site or area must be maintained; excluding deliveries that are performed with appropriate PPE or through contactless means. Log should contain contact information, such that all contacts may be identified, traced and notified in the event an employee is diagnosed with COVID-19. Cooperation with local health departments contact tracing efforts is required."

Timesheet Report - This tells you who was on the job site and when they were there. These are needed in case contact tracing measures need to take place from an infected worker (Filter & Export by date).
